Currently I am working in a start-up company developing MS Azure based services for training AI and providing AI based alternative monetization models for mobile app developers. There were 15 software professionals in two agile teams working under my supervision. I supported product management and development teams in specifying software product requirements and designing the technical implementation. Recruiting professionals into R&D and evaluating and contracting software consultant companies were part of my responsibilities.

My job included improving our company's working practices, working environment, tools and processes. I was strongly involved in developing and coaching our implementation of Scaled Agile Framework as well as our transformation towards team-based organization practices based on Holacracy.

Since 2007 I have worked in companies designing and implementing software systems based on Microsoft technologies. I am used to apply agile methodologies and supporting practices like test driven software development, automated unit and acceptance testing, continuous integration and continuous delivery. In addition to software design and implementation, I have years of experience on working as a software architect, a database designer, a user interface designer, a technical project manager, Scrum Master, a team leader and a manager.
